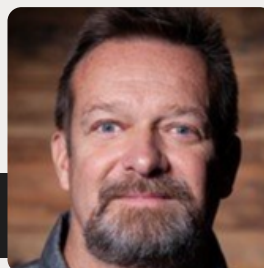

As we turn the calendar yet again to a new month, we focus our attention on the Christmas Toy Store. TriWest Network is focused on Strengthening, Planting, and Resourcing churches to fulfill the Great Commission. The Toy Store gives us the opportunity to meet the needs of these families but also allows us to share the Gospel. We are hoping to provide more toys for more families as well as ensure a more comprehensive follow-up from churches with each family. This is a great mission opportunity for you and your church! We need lots of volunteers to help in every aspect of this ministry. Would you consider how you can be a part of this ministry?

First, we need toys. We are expanding the number of families and children that will be served this year, so that means we need lots of toys.

Secondly, we need lots of volunteers. Set up will be from November 27 - December 1. Churches and donors are asked to drop off the toys at Braggtown Baptist Church between 10 am to 1 pm on these days. The Store will be open for shoppers on December 4-6. We need volunteers in the following areas:

Greeters - We always need people to greet and help families get to the store. It's important to have a smiling face to greet you and help the families.

Shopping - We need volunteers to walk around with the parents to help them shop for their children.

Counselors - We need pastors and trained leaders to pray with each family and share with them the true meaning of Christmas.

We also need churches willing to follow up with these families. Because a large percentage of our families are Hispanic, we need volunteers in each area who speak Spanish.
